Horizons NASDAQ 100 Covered Call ETF (the “Fund”), a series of Horizons ETF Trust I has declared a distribution payable on March 27, 2018 to shareholders of record as of March 22, 2018 with an ex-dividend date of March 21, 2018. This Notice is meant to provide you information about the sources of the Fund’s distributions. **No action is required on your part.**

The Fund distributes a monthly dividend of net investment income and any net short-term capital gains recognized in connection with the Fund’s equity call option activities calculated during each monthly dividend calculation period. *Cumulative distributions for the fiscal year to date have been re-characterized to reflect current designations. Payment of prior fiscal year capital gains available for distribution (which is known as a “spillover distribution”) have also been updated.
